Payments can be made by check or cash, and credit card payments can be made on our website at www.RAWD.org. Be advised that when you go through your bank and use bill-pay, they deduct it from your account and a third party issues checks which are mailed to us. That third party often holds on to those checks until they have enough to warrant sending through the mail. The check that they issue to Rio Alto can take over 10 days to be received by the District. Please allow adequate time to avoid a delinquent charge. Customers can also sign up for auto draft payments by completing the form found on our website or at the District office. This service is free and will ensure payment is received before delinquent charges are assessed.

Shasta Dam is currently releasing 6,415cfs. Consumption for the period 07/03/25 – 09/03/25 is 33.7% lower than 2013 consumption for the same period and year-to-date consumption is 23.7% lower than the year-to-date totals for 2013.

<u>Outdoor Irrigation</u>: As a reminder, for a limited time only, Lead Water Operator Scott Russell will be available to assist you with your watering questions and suggestions on how to keep your lawn green without overwatering. There is much uncertainty with future water regulations in the state of California, so if you are considering installing drought landscape, now is the time.

<u>Repairs/Maintenance:</u> Rio Alto and Solid Rock Construction will be doing major sewer repairs on Dinghy in late September or early October. Traffic control will be necessary, so we ask for your patience and respect for the workers on the street.
